- You can make decisions alone
- You can make decisions with help from one person you trust
- You can get help from lots of people you trust
- People you trust can help you understand choices, but with SDM, you still get to make the choice



MAKING SDM WORK

- Think about where/when you want help, who can help, and how
- Write down ideas and ask people to help you
- Make a plan on paper and talk a lot
- Change your plan when you need to



SDM IS FOR EVERYONE



No defined needs or supports



Power of Attorney and/or formal SDM agreement, Rep Payee or Trust



Limited or full guardianship or conservatorship
